

Instructions for shipping your KIP 8000 developer unit to Digital Printer Service

1. Remove all toner
2. Install regulation roller pressure release screws
3. Carefully pack the unit up in bubble wrap and preferably in the original box.
4. Fill out the bottom portion of this form and enclose in the box.
5. Enclose a check payable to Digital Printer Service for \$ 849.00

As you probably already know, the standard packaging of the 8000 dev unit is not the best. In order to ensure that your unit arrives to us in the best shape possible there are a couple of things you should do.

First, remove the bracket on the right side of the dev unit that has the small black connector on it. You can allow it to hang loose on the unit. Do not disconnect the wires. (this bracket always gets bent during shipping but it won't if it is not screwed in).

Second, be sure to add two or more foam pieces to both ends of the inner box. The bubble wrap is not enough to protect the vulnerable sides of the unit if it gets stood up on end. (as shown)

This is how the package looks when we ship it out of our location. We have had no damaged units to date.

Be sure to insure the package for whatever value you see fit. We recommend at least \$3000.*
